

## INCORRECT PATIENT INFORMATION PROVIDED ON BILLING STATEMENTS

**KANSAS CITY, Mo. — Nov. 9, 2016, —** Cerner, a global leader in health care technology, announced today that a printing issue resulted in an inadvertent disclosure of patient information on billing statements printed and mailed by Cerner for four of its health care provider clients, which included 622 patient statements from UHS Hospitals in Binghamton, New York. There is no evidence that any patient information has been used improperly. The issue was resolved and additional quality checks have been implemented.

The billing statements were mailed on Sept. 27 and included incorrect personal health information, such as patient and physician names, guarantor account number, billing account balances, medical descriptions and service location, printed on the back of the statements. No Social Security numbers or financial information were exposed as a result of the inadvertent disclosure. Letters are being mailed today to individual patients notifying them of the incident.
